Frequently Asked Questions

What are the requirements to apply to be in the Forensics or the Global Studies magnet program?

- A minimum of 2.0 Grade Point Average in each core academic subject area (e.g. language arts, mathematics, science, social studies) for the previous year and the first grading period of the current year combined.
- A minimum of 2.0 Grade Point Average in conduct for the core academic subject areas (e.g. language arts, mathematics, science, social studies) for the previous year and the first grading period of the current year combined.
- All effort grades in core academic classes must be a "2" or higher for the previous year and the first grading period of the current year combined.
- No more than 10 unexcused absences for the previous year and 5 unexcused absences for the first semester of the current year.

Is it required for Forensics or Global magnet students to take the Forensics Research or Global Research electives to be in the programs?

 No. These electives are offered solely to our magnet students to provide in-depth and hands-on studies in the magnet programs they have been accepted to, in addition to the field experiences they will receive on the magnet field trips.

Can a non-magnet student take the Forensics Research or Global Research elective?

No, non-magnet students may not take these electives.

What is an academy?

• An academy is an educational program that focuses on providing specialized and comprehensive learning experiences, with an emphasis on a specific area of study.

What is the advantage of being in the Arvida Fine Arts Academy?

• Through the AFAA, students can progress through one of our award-winning visual and performing arts of their choice (Art, Band, Chorus, Dance, Keyboard, and Theater). Committing to any one of the tracks in this academy enables students to gain high-level skills that will allow them to pursue their goals, including high caliber performances, state and national competitions, and admissions to the most competitive visual and performing arts high school magnet programs. No previous experience is required to be in the Arvida Fine Arts Academy.

What is the advantage of being in the Advanced Academic Academy?

• For students who are interested in a rigorous course of study, the AAA offers high school credit electives that can be taken alongside high school credit core classes such as Physical Science and Algebra. Our foreign language high school courses, Spanish and French, can be taken starting in 6th grade and enables students to satisfy the two credits of sequential foreign language instruction required for admission to all 4-year universities. In addition, we offer a dual enrollment option through Miami Dade College, which requires 3.0 GPA in a high school level course.

Can a student be in the Forensics or Global magnet programs AND in one of the academies?

• Yes. Any student, whether they are in a magnet or not, can be part of either academy and take any of the electives under the academies.

Can a student be in both academies?

Yes! Any student can take electives from both academies and/or any general studies electives.

Can a student be in one of Arvida's magnet programs AND in the Fine Arts Academy AND in the Advanced Academics Academy?

YES! At Arvida, students can do it ALL. For example, a Global Studies magnet student can
participate in all the hands-on Global Studies field experiences, while taking a Visual Art elective,
as well as taking Spanish to complete their high school foreign language requirement. Win-winwin!

All academy and general electives are available to all students, magnet and non-magnet.
